September-Valpolicella

Refreshing, fruity bouquet, rich texture (0,3,0)

Chardonnay-Semillion

A buttery textured wine with hints of honey and oak 3,3,0

October-Barolo

A rich, dense-textured wine, full flavored with fruits and oak. 3,4,0

Verdicchio

A delicate aroma and a clean crisp flavour with a hint of fruit and almonds. 0,3,0

November-Vieux Chateau du Roi (VCR)

A dark, full-bodied red wine with a warm bouquet of ripe berry fruit rounded with oak. 1,4,0

Gewurtztraminer

Aromatic and rich, with character of tropical fruit. 0,4,0

December-Rosso Grande

Our most full-bodied red wine, with flavours of ripe berries and an oaky aroma. 3,5,0

Chamblaise

A flavourful blend of a variety of grapes, this easy drinking wine is soft with a fruity aroma 0,2,0

Beer of the Month

September-Belgium Beer

Golden, medium hops clean tasting- 5%

October -Munich German Lager

Medium bodied, slightly hoppy 5.5%

November -Nova Scotia Ale

Back by popular demand - 5%

December - Rocky's Ale

Red amber, slightly roasty, full bodied- 5.5%

SEASONAL FEATURED WINES

This year Spagnols has introduced several new specialty wines which will go well during the holiday season.

Mulled Wine-This is a European tradition (sometimes known as Gluhwein or Vin Chaud) where red wine is combined with spices and served warm. Great for when the weather turns cold. It contains a mixture of cloves, allspice, cinnamon and orange peel.

Chocolate Orange Port—this wine has won the best in show dessert wine in many international amateur wine competitions. Rich aromas of dark chocolate with hints of refreshing citrus and vanilla.

White Chocolate Port- A thick, honey colored wine with a rich fruity nose- with the velvety smoothness of rich white chocolate. Winner of Winemaker Magazines Best in Show Dessert wine.

Cream Style Sherry - With the first sip of this sweet elixir, you are rewarded with flavours of roasted walnuts, brown sugar and dates. Serve chilled on its own or with nuts and cheese.

Cranapple Chardonnay-this easy drinking, crisp white wine features tart green apples balanced by smooth white cranberries. This kit sells out every year and is available while quantities last.
